Upgradation of the Institute

Since the Institute could not grow at Puri and has become non-functional hence the Ministry of Steel, shifted it to Kalinga Nagar Industrial Complex with effect from 1st March 2021. This is part of the upgradation program of the institute and is aligned with Purvodaya scheme of Govt. of India, which is in line with the AtmaNirbhar Bharat initiative of GOI, under which Ministry of Steel in collaboration with Govt. of Odisha has announced a mega-steel cluster at Kalinganagar. The Vision of the upgradation program is to make the Institute ready to provide industry ready degree/diploma engineers for the steel industry and skilled manpower for different trades. Already a course curriculum has been prepared with input from stakeholder industries and Ministry has applied for approval by SCTE&VT, Odisha for running the course from next academic year.
